The Wisconsin Biathlon Association invites you to try biathlon, the Olympic winter sport combining cross country skiing and rifle marksmanship. No experience is needed, all abilities welcome!



OPEN RACE: A 6km open race is for individuals with previous biathlon experience or those who are safety certified. Race format will be interval start with one prone and one offhand shooting stage.

NOVICE EVENT: The novice event is open those with limited practice time or no previous biathlon experience. This event will be 4km with one shooting stage. A safety demonstration, instruction, and practice time will take place prior to the event.

WHAT TO BRING: You provide the ski equipment, we'll supply the rest.

AGES: 12 and up. Due to Wisconsin law, participants must be at least 12 years of age.

AWARDS: Awards will be presented for places 1-3 in each age category of both races. All other entrants will receive a participation award.

RAFFLE: All participants will be entered to win some great prizes in our raffle drawing.

COST: Entry fee is \$20 for an individual. For each additional family member add \$15. This fee includes a mandatory USA Biathlon one day membership for insurance purposes.

REGISTRATION: All registration will be day of event only. Complete the form below along with the USBA membership form. Make checks payable to Wisconsin Biathlon Association.

LOCATION: The McMiller Sports Center is located 2.5 miles south of the Village of Eagle on County Hwy NN. From Eagle, travel south on Hwy 67, turn west of County Hwy NN to the McMiller Sports Center entrance.
